

Temporary overnight utility work along the north and south curbs of Clark Avenue East and Yonge Street

Expected timeline: July 14, 2025 to August 1, 2025

Work hours: Weekdays, 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.

What is happening?

To support future construction of the Yonge North Subway Extension, Alectra Utilities, working on behalf of Metrolinx are working on new hydro infrastructure by installing underground ducts and upgrading overhead electrical lines. This notice provides an update on work first communicated in May 2025. In the earlier stage, crews worked along Yonge Street near Glen Cameron Road and along Yonge Street between Morgan Avenue, and north of Clark Avenue. Temporary overnight work will take place at Yonge Street and Clark Avenue East. This work will help ensure future major construction activities like tunnelling can move forward smoothly.

About the Yonge North Subway Extension

The Yonge North Subway Extension will transform the commute in York Region, Toronto and beyond by extending the TTC's Line 1 service north from Finch Station to Vaughan, Markham and Richmond Hill. The project includes five new stations along an extension of roughly eight kilometres.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Your electricity service is not expected to be interrupted during this work.
- You may experience some increased noise caused by equipment and machinery.
- Access to homes and businesses will be always maintained.

WORK DETAILS:

- Crews will be carrying out different types of work including investigations, excavation along the road, sidewalks and crosswalks, and installing poles and cables.
- Work areas will be restored to their previous condition after the utility work is complete.
- **Please note: work may be rescheduled or extended due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.**

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS:

- North-east curb lane and south-east curb sidewalk at Clark Avenue East will be temporarily affected and pedestrians will be diverted. These curb closures will be closed one at a time with detour signage. Please follow posted signs to navigate safely around work zones.
- Crosswalks will remain open.
- Traffic control personnel will be present as needed to safely guide pedestrians and vehicle traffic.

TRAFFIC DETAILS:

- To safely complete this work, temporary lane closures will be required on Yonge Street and Clark Avenue East.
- Detour set up to re-route drivers around and back to Yonge Street.
- Paid duty officers will be present to ensure public safety.
- Expect minor traffic delays.
