


Tree removals along Morgan Avenue, Glen Cameron Road and Yonge Street

Expected timeline: as early as February 16, 2026, to April 1, 2026
(Protective fencing to be installed in advance)

Timing: Weekdays, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.



Approximate work zones are outlined in red. 20 trees will be removed from inside the work area marked in red as part of site preparation work.

What is happening?

To support future construction of the Yonge North Subway Extension, crews working on behalf of Metrolinx will be removing trees and pruning vegetation along Morgan Avenue, Glen Cameron Road, and Yonge Street. This work is needed to make sure future construction related to Clark Station can move forward safely and efficiently. Before any work begins, the area will be carefully checked for wildlife and active bird nests, and work will move forward following all required environmental and wildlife protection measures.

About the Yonge North Subway Extension:

The Yonge North Subway Extension will transform the commute in York Region, Toronto and beyond by extending TTC Line 1 subway service north from Finch Station to Vaughan, Markham and Richmond Hill. The project includes five new subway stations along an extension of roughly eight kilometres.

WORK DETAILS:

- Protective fencing will be installed around trees near work areas, as needed. Installation of fencing is expected to take place in advance of work commencing.
- A total of 20 trees will be removed.
- All removal and pruning of trees and vegetation in the area has been approved by the City of Markham and Vaughan.
- This work is expected to take approximately six weeks to complete.
- *Work may be rescheduled or delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.*

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- You may hear noise from equipment, including loaders and woodchippers, while work is underway.
- Additional site clearing will happen later as work moves forward.

PEDESTRIAN ACCESS:

- Work areas will be clearly marked and/or fenced off as required to keep everyone safe.
- Pedestrians should exercise caution around the work area.

TRAFFIC CHANGES:

- Short-term lane closures on Glen Cameron Road may be required to conduct tree removals.
- Signage will be posted to safely direct vehicles around the work area.

TRANSIT SERVICE:

- There is no expected impact to transit service.
