

Closure of Langstaff GO South parking lot

Expected timeline: Closure begins April 28, 2026.

Timing: Full 24 hour closure of impacted work areas.

What is happening?

To support future construction for the Yonge North Subway Extension, crews working on behalf of Metrolinx will be carrying out construction activities at and around the Langstaff GO south parking lot, south of the 407 and west of Cedar Ave.

About the Yonge North Subway Extension:

The Yonge North Subway Extension will transform the commute in York Region, Toronto and beyond by extending the TTC's Line 1 subway service north from Finch Station to Vaughan, Markham and Richmond Hill. The project includes five new subway stations along an extension of roughly eight kilometers.

WORK DETAILS:

- Crews working on behalf of Metrolinx will be conducting various construction activities that require the full closure of the parking lot, including utility relocations like electrical, watermain, storm sewer, and cellular tower relocations.
- The closed parking lot area may also be used as a laydown or staging area for machinery and materials.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Work areas will be clearly marked or fenced off as required to ensure public safety.
- An emergency access path for pedestrians will be maintained with a fenced off laydown area inside the parking lot in the event of an emergency scenario.
- Crews will conduct daily inspections to ensure that hazards are minimized or eliminated.
- You may notice increased noise during work hours. Noise and vibration levels will be monitored, and steps will be taken to bring levels down, when necessary.
- ***Please note that work may be rescheduled or delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.***

PEDESTRIAN IMPACTS:

• ALL PASSENGER/PEDESTRIAN ACCESS VIA LANGSTAFF GO SOUTH LOT WILL BE CLOSED.

- The public will not be able to access the platform from Langstaff GO South. The passenger pick-up and drop-off area in the South lot will be closed. Passengers and pedestrians will need to access all GO Trains and Buses from the Langstaff GO North Lot off Red Maple Rd.
- Work areas will be clearly marked and/or fenced off as required to keep everyone safe.
- An emergency access path for pedestrians will be maintained with a fenced off Emergency Assembly Area inside the parking lot in the event of an emergency scenario prohibiting access to the platform exits near the north end of the platform.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS:

- All parking spaces in the south parking lot will be closed indefinitely to support the YNSE.
- Three accessible parking spaces will be temporarily relocated to the northeast corner of the north parking lot, near the temporary bus stops on Red Maple Rd. near the entrance to the north parking lot.
- Please plan and give yourself extra time for parking at the station.
- Please park in the designated GO Transit parking lots only. Parking at adjacent lots not owned by GO Transit is done at the customer's own risk.

TRANSIT IMPACTS:

- The current GO bus stop will be relocated to a temporary location on Red Maple Rd. near the entrance to the north parking lot. Passengers will need to access all GO Trains and Buses from the Langstaff GO North Lot off Red Maple Rd. Signage redirecting passengers will be installed at the former GO bus stop.
